



care and keeping of SlapStick Dry-erase Boards

Now that your new dry-erase board has been installed, it's important to keep it in good working condition. You want it to last a long time, don't you?

Most boards include a SlapStickKit. It includes an eraser, two markers, and cleaning solution. Using these markers and eraser will give you the best results. Spray the cleaning solution after each use and wipe with a soft cloth.

We realize you may have previously purchased dry-erase markers you'd like to use. We recommend using the markers included in the kit. Because of the stain-resistant properties in our dry-erase coating, certain markers tend to repel. This effect will diminish within six weeks of installation. If you're purchasing markers on your own, we suggest Center Stage brand sold through Corporate Express.

If you accidentally use a permanent marker, the SlapStick cleaning solution should remove it. Wipe the area multiple times until it disappears. If the problem persists, write over the stained area with a dry-erase marker and use the eraser to wipe off.
